A discussion was held on the following topics:

- Possible annexation of the area by Seattle or Burien
- The Growth Management Act relating to annexations
- A possible contract for service with Seattle Fire Department
- The need for North Highline to have someone in a leadership role
- Contingency plans if the contract with District 2 is withdrawn
- The utilization of BC's as temporary Interim Chief
- Differences in call volumes between North Highline, District 2, Tukwila and SeaTac
- Locations of fire stations (Seattle, North Highline, Burien)
- The possible date of BC Malo's retirement


The Battalion Chiefs then went over some of the items they are working on and have completed including budgeting, public relations, personnel and scheduling, and the department's future.
